The conference will be held at South Kilburn High School, Stafford Rd., London NW6.

If you are arriving before Friday 18th, please if possible tell us the date and time in advance. You can phone 778 2782 when you arrive.

If you are arriving on Friday before 6.30pm, phone 452 1338, or if you speak only German phone 624 1437 (we hope to have someone there who can speak some German.) We will be waiting to meet you at 67 Brondesbury Villas, London NW6, which is in Kilburn near the school. If you are arriving by air, go by coach to Victoria Terminal, and then walk to Victoria Railway Station, where you can get a number 16 bus to Brondesbury Villas, or the underground ("tube") to Kilburn Park. (If you take the underground you need the Queens Park branch of the Bakerloo Line - the brown line on the underground map. The underground is more complicated than the bus, but faster in the rush hour and on Saturday, when the bus is very slow. To get to the Bakerloo line take the Victoria line to Oxford Circus and change trains there.

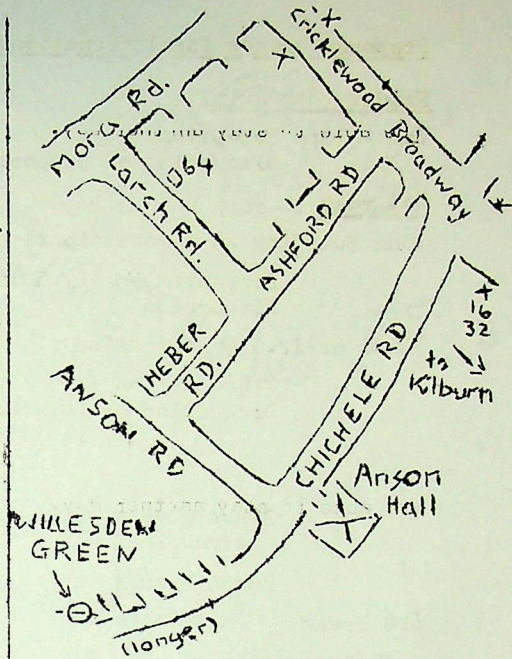
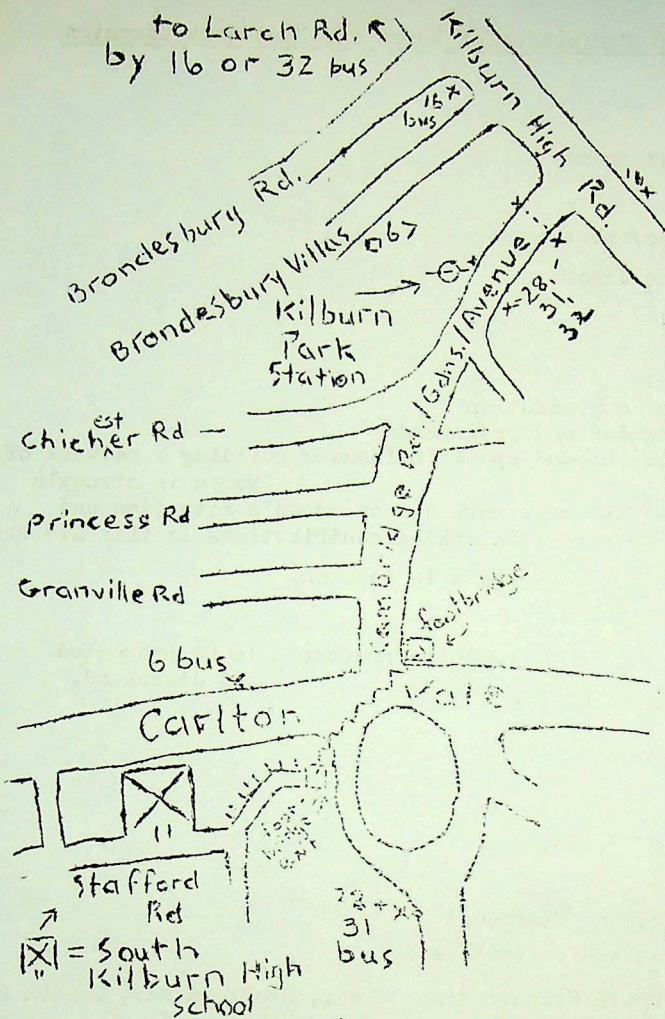
If you are arriving on Saturday, or after 6.30 on Friday, at Heathrow airport, the fastest way to get to the school is to go by coach to We st London air terminal at Cromwell Rd., and ask directions to a 28 or 31 bus.

If you are arriving by train, or by air to Gatwick airport, you can go straight to Victoria Station and follow the directions above.

We hope to find places for everyone to sleep without paying. Please bring a sleeping bag, and please let us know as soon as possible how many will be coming from your country. This is very important. For those who have to pay the cost will be shared.

The major costs of the conference will be a) the hall; b) if women are able to come from Northern Ireland and Portugal we will pay their fares (otherwise no one will be able to attend from these countries). Since we will not ourselves be travelling the POW Collective will make the major contribution to these costs, but we will not be able to meet them alone. To avoid heavy collections from these attending groups may want to contribute collectively towards making the international conference possible. // We

have just heard that 20-30 women will probably be attending from Italy. They will bring a videotape of their big May 1st wages for housework demo. They have requested that we extend the conference to continue on Monday. Please let us know if you will

If you are coming by bus (16, 8, or 176) up Kilburn High Rd, get off at Cambridge Avenue, which is the street that Kilburn Park Station is in.

If you are coming on the underground, get off at Kilburn Park station (Bakerloo line, Queen's Park branch), and turn right outside the station.

Walk down Cambridge Avenue, which becomes Cambridge Rd just past the station. Keep walking until you come to a big intersection. Cross over the road using the footbridge, which is on the corner of Cambridge Rd and Carlton Vale. At the bottom of the footbridge on the other side, turn left and go along a small path, which has a fence running alongside of it to the right, and a big block of flats on the left. When the fence ends, turn along the road to the right, and Kilburn High School, is a short way along, on the right.

Directions pour arriver a South Kilburn High School (Ecole Secondaire)

Si tu viens en autobus (bus 8, 16, ou 176) en t'approchant de Kilburn High Rd, descends a Cambridge Avenue (demanda au conducteur de t'indiquer l'arrêt).

Si tu prends le metro, descends a la station Kilburn Park (sur la ligne Bakerloo, qui va dans la direction de Queens Park). La sortie de la gare se trouve sur Cambridge Avenue.

Descends Cambridge Avenue a droite, qui devient Cambridge Road, juste apres le metro. Continue jusqu'a ce que tu arrives a un grand croise. Traverse la rue par un petit pont (expres pour les pietons) qui se trouve au coin de Cambridge Rd et Carlton Vale. Sur l'autre cote du petit pont, tourne a gauche et prends un petit chemin qui a une petite barriere a sa droite et un grand batiment d'appartements a sa gauche. A la fin prends la rue a droite. Kilburn High School se trouve tout pres a droite.

Se venite in autobus (16, 8, 176) sulla Kilburn High Rd, scendete a Cambridge Avenue. Se venite in metropolitana, scendete alla stazione di Kilburn Park (sulla linea Bakerloo in direzione di Queens Park). All' uscita della stazione girate a destra su Cambridge Avenue, e continuate fino a un grande incrocio. Attraversate la strada servendovi del ponticello per i pedoni, che si trova all' angolo di Cambridge Ave. e Carlton Vale. In fondo al ponticello, girate a sinistra, seguendo un sentiero che ha uno steccato a sinistra e un grande blocco di appartamenti a destra. Kilburn High School si trovera sulla destra.

The address on Randolph Crescent shown on the previous map has nothing to do with the conference and should not have been on the map.
