# INDOCHINA SOLIDARITY CONFERENCE

The war in Indochina has reached a new and vital turning point. As a result of the heroic military and political achievements of the Indochinese people, a settlement may be in sight which should result in the total withdrawal of all American military and civilian personnel. But it is precisely at this stage that they need, even more, our solidarity.

First, we must work to bring about a settlement based on the principle of self-determination. Second, we must interpret the settlement accurately, and guard against all attempts to misrepresent its terms or undermine it, especially by the British government in connivance with the US. Third, we must be prompt to mobilise against all efforts by the US to continue the war openly or by covert means.

The need for clear understanding and action in Britain by all those who are in solidarity with the Indochinese people is greater than ever before. As a first step, an ad hoc group of organisations and individuals is sponsoring the Indochina Solidarity Conference, to mobilise all possible forces for a positive discussion on how best to demonstrate our solidarity in this new situation. We would like to see the Conference lead to the establishment of a new and broader solidarity movement, to ensure that the US gets out of Indochina for good.

The Conference will be held from 10 a.m. Saturday 2nd December to 1 p.m. Sunday 3rd December, at the Conway Hall, Red Lion Square, London, W.C.1. Speakers will include representatives of the Indochinese, Noam Chomsky and Malcolm Caldwell. There will be films, and workshops to discuss the present situation in Indochina, British complicity, the strategy of imperialism, and further action in this country. The Conference is designed to respond to the clear call of the Vietnamese for united action to support their cause.

We urge you, as an individual or an organisation, to join us (a) by sponsoring the Conference and joining its preparatory committee (b) by helping with your time and money. Please let us have your support now.
