THE STATE MACHINERY INTENSIFIES ATTACKS ON BLACK AND OPPRESSED PEOPLE

It is clear that Britain today is moving swiftly into complete open facism. Attacks on blacks in Britain are becoming more and more openly expressed both in theincreasing number of individual acts of violence against the oppressed people and the considerable extension of the State's power of oppression of black people in particular. This climate of racism was successfully brought forward by both the Labour and Tory Governments over a number of years.

"OPERATION CLEAN-UP" - THE NEVILLE ROAD INCIDENT

In Forest Gate, London, E.7, at Neville Road, a peaceful party was being held at a family's home. At about 12.30 a van load of pigs invaded the party ordered the people out, harassed and then arrested seven people for no reason whatsoever. When one brother asked "what are you arresting me for, what have I done" the pig who was dragging him away said "I,'ll think of something later". After being brutally beaten while in custody he was charged with "obstruction"; on his release from custody, he managed to get to East Ham Hospital where it was proved that he was suffering from concussion as a result of a blow on the nose, that was early Sunday morning. The next day, Monday, he appeared at East Ham Magistrates Court. Further hearing of the charges brought against the brothers will take place on Monday, 29th November, 1971 at West Ham Magistrates Court at 10 a.m.

This attack by the pigs is in keeping with a planned systematic attack scheme under the guise of a para military operation termed "Operation Clean-up". In keeping with the details of this plan, the police are authorised to stop and act brutally (as is the nature of pigs' mentality), in all black Peoples Partys in the Newham area and all other black communities. This is only a start of the tenor to come. Keep in mind the Immigration Bill '71 and all its facist powers. Be informed, get organised.

"THE RAILROADING OF COMRADES, ELI, HALL AND CHRIS

On Tuesday 16th November, 1971, at the Inner London Quarter Sessions, three comrades were 'found guilty' on various 'charges'. Comrade Eli was found guilty of 'assault occasioning grevious bodily harm' and was sentenced to six months imprisonment. Bros. Hall and Chris were both found guilty on two charges, their sentence is pending a report from the Probation Officers.

BACKGROUND TO THE RAILROADING

The railroading of the comrades resulted from a demonstration which was held in London on April, 26th, 1970 to show solidarity with the just struggles of the people of Trinidad and Tobago, against intensified oppression by the imperialist forces, headed by the United States and British forces and aided and abetted by the Williams puppet Government which resulted in the arrest of eighteen people. The following day the 27th, Brothers, Eli, Hall and Chris

were present at the Marlborough St. Magistrates Court to hear the charges and in support of the arrested comrades. After the hearing plain clothes and uniformed pigs lined the streets from the court to Oxford Circus station they provoked, intimidated and eventually vamped on the people who defended themselves; however, a number of people were arrested including brothers. Eli, Hall and Chris. Because of these brothers whrelenting and persistant striggle against this decadent capitalist system, they were singled out for so-called "sp ecial theatment"; which finally resulted in their being convicted after a lapse of eighteen months. Subsequently, other people had charged dropped against them, because the pigs had no evidence to submit. Other people were held for up to seven hours without charges.

These are not isolated incidents, but well calculated by the state machine They are commonplace occurances on a national and international scale in dealing with the black and oppressed peoples just struggle.

INTERNATIONAL RACISM

International racism today is apparent in all capitalist sountries. Look at South Africa. Look at Zimbahwe (Rhodesia). Britain is at present engaged in the sale of 5 million black people!! The black and the weak are always victimes to the white and the strong. The white man's sterile words of censure against a minority of white squatters and poachers on the blackman's soil of Africa are quite in contrast to his "law and order" enforced by bullet and bayonet in tiny and indrendence-loving Anguilla; and the just struggles of the People of Trinidad and Tobago to name but a few, but then the contrast hinges on the difference between black and white. Like father, like son, its the same with the forked tongue capitalist oppressor and as far as the black people are concerned they have no legal or human rights that white terror is bound to respect: Further, in contrast to White Rhodesia, where British troops rublicly stated that they would not fire on white brigand squatters; black and little Arguilla, Trinidad and Tobago, and all other black occupied countries, Colonies the white oppressor rides rough-shod over the peace-loving peoples, whelding force under the boot of military aggression and illegal occupation. The capitalist oppressor use the state machinery in the form of the army, the legislature and the Police (the hatchetemen of the boos class) to intensify the oppression of the peace loving people.

Workers of the World emite: To swome - extend the fight on all fronts! At present in Britain we have brownerable cases of political prisoners, e.g. the Mangrove Nine, the EWCO Three, the Metro Youth Club and a number of brothers and sisters from the B.U.F.P., to name but a few. Meanwhile the pig-judge in Leeds Assizes trial, advised the jury to return a verdict of not guilty, in the case concerning the murder of brother Oluwale although there is substantial evidence supported by <u>Police Officers</u> to merit conviction of the accused.

To be forewarmed is to be forearmed! Black people never receive justice in the Courts. Black people must take their justice on the streets, because there is no justice in racist courts.

TO BE FOREWARNED IS TO BE FOREARMED:

The purpose of this leaflet is to inform you of your inalienable rights and the method of safeguarding them. The British government intends to introduce a new Immigration Bill very shortly which, in effect, will enhance racial division, impose residence and job restrictions, surveillance and registration of immigrants by the police, will empower the government to use deportation as a political weapon in order to silence any protest from the black national minority or individuals.

This Bill is in essence a denial of the human and democratic rights we all cherish and is embodied in the United Nations Charter on Human Rights of which Britain is a signatory. What is the strategic objective of the British Buling Class? What are they out to achieve by passing the New Immigration Bill '71?

(1) To harass black working people and generally to make life intolerable for them. Those who break under the strain of intense racism, the doors of repatriation are open.

"Submit or out."

- (2) 2) A method of knowing the addresses, workplaces etc., of those black people who
 speak out loud against injustice and
 also to isolate them from the black working masses.

 Frame ups, railroading into the courts
 and prisons will increase.
- (3) It is just a trick to say that new-comers, (subject to the Immigration Bill '71) only will have to carry registration cards.
 With time this will lead inevitably to all black people carrying identification cards.
- 4 The patriel and non-patrial clauses establish firmly the racist basis of British society. The bill for ulterior motives is injecting more racism into the consciousness of white people. Why? Because the monopoly-capitalist ruling class is on its

death's bed and has become so politically bankrupt that the only way it can now win the allegiance of the white working masses is by poisoning their minds against the workers and peasants of Asia, Africa, Caribbean and Latin America. But they will miserably fail for this is against the trend of history and progress.

The Covenant on Economic, Social and Cultural Rights recognises the right of everyone to work, to fair wages, to social security, to adequate standards of living and freedom from hunger, to health and to education. The Covenant, on Civil and Political Rights recognises the right of everyone to freedom of thought, conscience and religion, freedom of opinion and expression, and freedom, peaceful assembly and association; and the right of everyone to be protected against cruel, inhuman, or degrading treatment. It also guarantees preservation of the cultural, religious and linguistic heritage of min-

BRITISH IMPERIALISM IN CRISIS:

By proposing this Bill the British government has demonstrated quite clearly that it means to deny equality to substantial sectors of the populace. In practice, second-class citizenship will have been created based on the sole reason of ethnic origin and forced into subservience by decree.

You entered this country as free citizens on a basis of equal rights. Are you now willing to go into bondage voluntarily? What is to prevent any British government from extending registration to all blacks or the five year limit to ten or even twenty years? Even today blacks with United Kingdom passports and citizenship have no right to settle in Britain.

Will we, the Afro-Asian and Caribbean national minority in Britain submit to this blatantly racist and repressive legislation? Can the devilish inhumanity of the pass-laws of fascist South Africa be transmitted to Britain? The answer is an uncompromising NO.

We sternly warn the British Government that in the pursuance of this repressive measure it will unleash forces which will result in mass civil disobedience. In fact it will be lifting a rock to drop it on its own feet. We remind the British government that gone are the days forever of the meek, submissive and blinded working class, black or white, with ever an ingratiating smile for the scraps thrown them.

istence of 70 years and its ostensible committal to socialism has been the most vociferous in defending the millionaire class. The treachery of labour leaders can no longer be defended.

Lame-duck industries, which once upon a time brought great profit to their owners, have and are being nationalised and compensation far exceeding their worth has been paid. The composition of the governers running state concerns nevertheless remains the same and is geared in the interests of big business. Electricity, gas, water, coal, transport is sold cheaper per unit to the factory owners than the working people.

The contesting parties (all serving the same boss for none other will be tolerated) publish their manifestos for the coming elections and terms such as, "national interest, "Law and Order" soul and Compassion", "Justice and Equality" etc. abounded in the 1970 elections, but none of them explain in detail the methods to be employed to translate their promises into objective facts.

"National Interest"? but this nation is composed of a few rich and the many living hand to mouth. Does it therefore mean that they can serve the interests of both? Which are in reality antagonistic. How will they do it?

"Law and Order"? This slogan mouthed from way back in the last century to Hitler of late, is a clear sign of the political bankruptcy of the capitalist class, when it can no longer deceive and bribe the labouring classes into submission with crumbs. All struggles for justice, for a better life, for the right to political dissent, against racism and imperialist plunder and slaughter will be repressed viciously under the name of "Law and Order".

Abstract terms as "Soul and Compassion" can only be understood when they take the material form of justice seen by all to be done.

Look it! Since then every gut-twisted promise has been contemptuously broken. There exist to-day in Britain, dispersed but large pockets of powerty. The shackles of false thinking engendered in the minds of the poverty-stricken must be shattered for it is now extensively propagated by the mass-media that the sole responsibility for their condition is due to being a blockhead or a lay about.


The Lessons Learnt From History

Nixon has confessed that "the World has dramatically shanged" and Western Europe and Japan have recovered their economic strength". This fact has intensified the struggle against U.S. control, therefore Nixon admits that to believe in the preponderant American influence that was the natural sequence of post-war conditions would be self lefeating today". It is time he says to form "mature partnerships". This only to say Nixon hopes to control U.S. "allies" through "partnership" relations involving them in "a sharing of the responsibility" for U.S. aggression i.e. to get American chestnuts out of the global fire. This is wishiful thinking for America's

"allies" will continue to move away (Common Market) and deepen the contradictions between them.

Mixon is looking hard for substitute cannon fodder. He speaks of many newly independent countries of Asia, Africa and Latin America as "the growing independent forces". It has therefore become necess ary to help this group of "partners" to "develop their own strength". This in actualism "furnishes military and economic assistance" while its to suppress people's movements to suppress people's movements towards genuine independence and social justice. In plain words the U.S. will provide the money and the guns and the reactionaries in these countries the men.

He engineered the invasion of Cambodia (a country that had preserved peace for 16 years and remained neutral) with U.S. troops. He banned the flames of war to the whole of Indo-China by lawnching a large-scale invasion of Laos, (using the combined forces of the U.S. aggressor troops, Saigon puppet forces, and Thai mercenaries. The recent disclosures of secret papers by the New York Times only confirm the fact that imperialism has a foundation of lies and utter corruptness which weigh like a mountain on the people. RECKONING ONE YEAR ATER

The borough and district council elections have just ended throughout Britain and the impression given by the mass media's mind-benders was "...... Citizens, witness local democracy at work!", but deliberately concealed the fact that on the average only 30% of the people cared to cast their vote. A simple breakdown of this vote shared by the permissible parties reveals that the aldermen and councillors elected took office on the strength of but 10-15% of the total population.

Just over a year ago we recall the billionaire controlled press, radio and television
set the stage to create and promote to a
frenzy the gigantic fraud which went under the
name of "The General Election", as to which
party (bunch of scoundrels and lackeys) will
sit in parliament and administer the state,
devising new methods for manipulating and exploiting the broad working masses in the light
of changing conditions and genred, as always, in
the interests and perpetuation of the rule of
the monopoly capitalists.

The voters in the latter election were 70% of registered voters. A similar breakdown of the votes shows that the Conservatives carry the so-called mandate on behalf of no more than 30% of the population.

Yet there are many innocent working folk who believe that this capitalist parliamentary democracy is mass democracy - government by the people and for the people - are they not as likely to believe that St. George was indeed the world renowned dragon slayer he is reputed to be for does not the proof of this feat lie in the fact that nowhere on this earth is a dragon to be seen today.

What is the explanation for this disenchantment and the banging of crosses once every five years? And what trend does this signify? The answer can only be that the capitalist parliamentary system is breaking down. The congruent parts of this machinery are spent and worn and all that remains to be done is the journey to the breakers yard and its relegation to the scrap heap of history.

At election times into the political arena step a rat-bag of agents and apologists of all hues and groupings of the capitalists and imperialists, to act out parts allotted to them by their billionaire masters. Their stock-in-trade to a man is political deception of the broad working masses. Their rewards (ministerships, royal commissions, directorships on the managing boards of company's, trusts, cartels, banks etc.) are commensurate to the level of skullduggery they will descend to in the service of the money-bags. The so-called protagonists for parliamentary seats, call them Labour, Tory, Liberal or what you will, aided and abetted by the mass-media appear to lash out at each others degenerate inclinations and proclaiming their own imaginary virtues. Their forked tongues dripping to savour the loot that will lie within their grasp, should they perchance worm here

Such in reality were and are the "peoples representatives". Such in reality will be a people's lot; a dehumanising and servile one should they continue to entrust their destiny into the hands of known and unknown opportunists, blatant exploiters, racist dogs and ardent imperialists.

Awaken all you dispossessed and down-trodden! For only fools and the inept will dare to dance before the blind and beat drums near the deaf. The "peoples representatives" although not fools know well that they can get away with rhetoric, bombast, lies and of broken promises because the people are not politically conscious.

In fact we can state with surety that in all states where the rule of capital holds sway and where the debacle of such multi-ring circuses (periodic elections to decide which group of exploiters and boot-lickers jostle closer to the booty) are indulged in and accepted is in truth the measure of the political backwardness of the working class. The stage we are passing through now testifies to the heightened political awareness of the working people by their rejection in increasing numbers of the lies and hypocrisy of the "peoples representatives" and hence an increasing resistance to further exploitation. When this transformation is complete and the latters exposure as the basest of men polarises, we shall have reached a situation where under any pretext this breed of humbugs will suspend the parliamentary machine and enact martial laws to forcibly repress the people of Ireland, Greece, Pakistan, Dominican Republic, and many other in countries are the recent wictims). The velvet glove will be ripped off having served its purpose and the iron fist revealed. Once again the toiling masses will be plunged into misery and degradation if their forces are not organtised and prepared to face this onslaught by this most cruel and parasitic class (capitalist ruling class) whose history has been written in the annals of mankind in letters of blood and tire.

The social-democratic or Labour parties in capitalist/imperialist countries play an important and necessary role in the political arena which strengthens the rale of capital. In liberal RHETORIC, it is considered a provocative act to irritate racists, it never seems to the same old racist. They see quite clearly that all logic and all law, they insist that the robbed there is no distinction between the aggressor and the victim of oppression. Universally liberals are

paternalistic, patronizing, condescending and they think they can tell poor people how to frame their posture of protest-how to scream and how to cry or indeed whether they should cry at all. The word conflict seperates liberals and politically conscious workers, they want orderly change within the existing framework, politically conscious workers want change orderly if possible, disorderly if necessary. The liberal accepts that man must be liberated, but disagrees on the method for liberation. Racial prejudice is irrational to its core yet he insists that an oppressed national minority fight rationally. Mealy mouthed pussy footing is the dominant liberal value. Liberals fear violence more than anything else, because violence, more than anything else illuminates the precarious balance of their posture and erodes their material foundations.

liberal leadership has no programme and when it has a programme it deals with symptons rather than causes which categorise them as missionary minded sentimentalists and exceedingly cautious do gooders frightened to get their fringers burnt. In the final analysis institutional and administrative liberals are of little value. They all work within a power context controlled by men who are unequivocally opposed to changes in the status quo. Liberals cannot make changes or convert anyone until they convert themselves.

Will they identify with the oppressed or the oppressor, the exploited or the exploiter? The question goes abegging. He is always on the side of the victor in a conflict. As most liberals are rich enough to be liberals, it is most important that they stand, wherever they are, in their offices, in their unions, in their neighbourhood, in their churches and declare what god they serve and what visions they have seen. Some liberals want change but almost all liberals want to achieve it without cost or pain. Everybody is going to have to pay something. What holds the liberal back is his essential support of what exists - now they are committed to ways and means and men who are respectable and responsible. But to be responsible to a situation of oppression is of necessity, to be an oppressor or at least an accomplice of the crime. If defenders of the status quo are permitted to define responsibility and respectability, then men who cling to those values must, of necessity, serve men who make definitions. If the church loved brotherhood as much as it fears sex, we would now be celebrating the coming of the kingdom of man. There is no power outside the councils of power that could sustain hate for a moment if it were not sustained inside the council of power. Liberals are not the disease they are the symptoms of man and the office of fact, many men of power and many liberals are now convinced that justice for the national minorities would prevent them being in possession council of their share of the cake and and of other peoples' table.

To conclude the liberals must face up to the facts that every advance the suffering and exploited masses have made in their condition dating from time immemorial, has been by earth shaving convulsions which have toppled the old order to be replaced by the new. Vicious Attack Nurses At Mile Hospital End 0

In a racist society such as Britain racism is found everywhere. One of the ways in which it has raised its head of late is in the hospitals; attacks of all kinds are being made on Black nurses, in various ways. In many hospitals the Salmon Scheme is being implemented, this Scheme will relegate the black nurses to do all the scavenging work in the wards. e.g. cleaning and carrying, emptying of bed-pans, cleaning patients etc., and 90% of the black nurses will be doing this scavenging job when the scheme is in full operation. It will have reduced the chances of black nurses of ever being trained and qualifying as State Registered Nurses.

At the Mile End General Hospital a few weeks ago a black sister tutor was first attacked by the matron because of her natural hair style. It is believed that the sister left the hospital soon after this; in course of time many more black nurses came under fire from the matron. She went so far as to say that had she interviewed the girls, they would not have been engaged. This is now a common happening in many hospitals. The matron went on to say that the black nurses looked 'untidy' with their natural hair style and that they belonged to some political organisation. She even went to the extent as to keep a strict observation on the types of

Why are these increasing attacks launched on Black Nurses in particular and on Black people in general? Because black people are becoming more and more politically conscious now that being the case, they are defining and asserting for themselves thus strengthening the historical links with their social and cultural heritage destroyed cruelly by the colonialists and imperialists.

The reason we are here is because of the plunder and control of our natural resources by the Western Imperialist, sold out by the Iackey National Governments in the Third World. Now that the economic strings (Raw Materials) are being cut by the growing political awareness of the peoples of the Third World, (Africa, Asia, Iatin America, the Caribbean) British ruling class is now seeking other avenues to safeguard their interests. At present they are attempting for the second time since the turn of the century to come to an agreement with the reactionary ruling circles in Western Europe for co-ordinating robbery of the working peoples. In applying for membership the British monopoly capitalists are jettisoning the remaining interests of the so-called "Commonwealth" because it has outlived its

Haringey with WEST INDIAN Council S aga in Children 3 Tug-of-War

A so-called "new deal" for all West Indian school children in Haringey is being urged on the borough education committee by the North London West Indian Association and other progressive groups, following a national report out earlier this month.

According to the report 28.7 per cent of the immigrant children in Haringey and the "Immigrant Pupils in England" points out that the West Indian children are at the lowest rung of the educational ladder. West Indians are getting less help than other immigrant children; too many are in educationally sub-normal schools, deliberately and wilfully classified ESN pupils. For more than two years black organisations have been pointing out the racist attack on black children in education, particularly Haringey with its Educationally Sub-Normal classification what is happening in Haringey is not accidental, it is deliberate. It is a deliberate policy of the ruling class who owns and controls the riches of the country to implement policies that would serve the capitalist system. Thus the pattern in education, housing, employment and so on is a common practice against the poor and oppressed workers and in favour of the capitalist ruling class.

The National Foundation For Educational Research in England and Wales written by H.E.R. Townsend, points out that the West Indian community have "grounds for ill-feeling" over the treatment of their children. Five times as many West Indian children are in ESN schools, as Pakistani children, seven times as Indian children, three times as many as non-immigrant children. It shows that West Indian children attending grammar schools are: 1.58 per cent, the smallest number of all racial groups, comparing with 2.46 per cent of Pakistanis, 3.93 per cent of Indians, 8.41 per cent of other immigrants and 20.33 per cent of non-immigrant children (these figures are very much understated). In Haringey alone there are about 250 or more of these children, some attending school in the borough and others in

Who teach black children in this society are tainted with racism. Worst of all black children in this society are tainted with racism. Worst of all black children in this country are from different economic, social, historical and cultural backgrounds from their white teachers and because of this difference in many cases the teachers are not interested in understanding and teaching the black child. It has been mentioned by many young pupils that teachers often throw a bunch of grapes to them and tell them to "go and draw" or box their ears and slap their faces. The black child receives little by way of help from his

It is the duty of all black and progressive parents to make enquiries regularly about the education of their children. As members of the education of their children. As members of the public, rate-payers, and tax-payers, they should insist that their rates and taxes are spent to provide a proper education for their children. An education that is related to our history and culture and not divorced from our economic devel-

Education should be implemented in a way that serve the interests of the majority of the people. Teaching, training and education should not be restricted only to the schoolroom, and divorced from the activities of the life of the people.

As long as the workers are oppressed by the capitalist ruling class and as long as the school-rooms are dominated by the minions of the capitalist ruling class the problem of racism in education will remain. The working people should be in control of their schools and thus direct the type of education necessary for the all-round development of their children, this should be an education controlled by the people, and in the interests of the great majority.

Organise to obtain proper education now! Organise to end racism in education!


