## SOMETHING ABOUT US

Agitprop contains an educational and research collective that works with committed people to support struggles for liberation. These struggles are around the exploitation of work, the rigidity of sexual roles, the domination of Third World peoples, and the decadence of the culture.

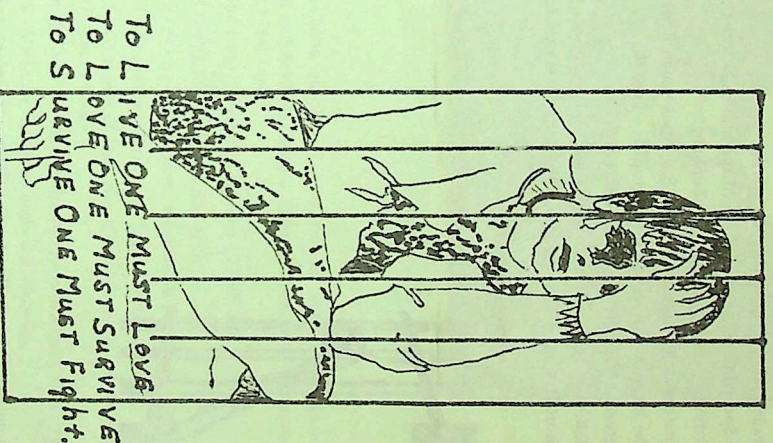
As the anger of the people grows, so too grows our movement's need to breakdown the isolation of our lives and revolutionary actions and surround the confusion about capitalism that has kept us oppressed for far too long. Agitprop as a group attempts to bridge this isolation and confusion by publishing short pamphlets, by creating a distribution network, distributing information on struggles, and by assisting research projects. Agitprop as a collective seeks to build a new social unit that can help us confront our fears about struggling, and learn to love closely our sisters and brothers and to hate openly our enemies.

An outline of our 4 main projects is presented so as to invite criticism, support and assistance.

1. The POLITICAL BOOKSHOP operates as a collection point for activists and it produced this literature list.
2. The PAMPHLET AND POSTER PUBLISHING project has re-printed articles on women's and gay oppression, on techniques of propaganda, on legal repression, on power structure research, racism and imperialism.
3. The LEGAL REPRESSION project operates an emergency political legal first-aid service and assists people in the political preparation of cases to the courts and to the real jury - the people.
4. The INFORMATION WORK is built around a steady supply of current leaflets, posters, letters, and papers, an updated list of activist groups, and a library of left publications.

We can supply political groups with bulk supplies of literature for their own internal use or for a specific purpose at a meeting, rally, school, or local market political display.

In general we use the following arrangement.

1. All materials we have at the bookshop are available on sale or return.
2. If a group needs a discount in order to raise money for their own projects, we can give you a discount of 15% to 33%. Other discounts depend on how we originally received the material.
3. However, we ask that groups pay in advance for what they need because we are very hard pressed to extend more credit. If this presents serious difficulties for you too, let us know and we can try to arrange something. If the materials are not sold, they can be returned for other publications, credit, or cash, as you specify.
