The National Abortion Campaign is sponsoring a demonstration in London on June 21st to protest against the James White Abortion (Amendment) Bill which has already received a second reading in Parliament and could become law at any time. This Bill would:-

- 1) severely restrict the grounds for an abortion thus reducing the number of abortions performed under the National Health Service by more than two-thirds.
- 2) prevent any foreign women from coming to Britain for an abortion - this is particularly crucial as Great Britain and the Netherlands are the primary outlets for European women from countries with even harsher restrictions.
- seriously curtail information and advice, especially to minors.

We appeal to you for support and solidarity. The conference of Mouvement pour la Liberte de l'Avortement et de la Contrapption in Paris last month sponsored the demonstration which, in view of International Women's Year, we wish to make international in scope. We ask you to:

- a) send contingents to London for the June 21st demonstration. (Tear off slip at the end for accommodation).
- b) picket British Embassies and Consulates in your own countries on June 21st.
- c) send telegrammes or letters of protest to: Barbara Castle, Secretary of State, House of Commons, London, SEI. Also please send a copy of this telegramme or letter of support to National Abortion Campaign, 80 Railton Road, London, SE24, which we can read to people at the demonstration.
