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My dear Brigitte,

Two matters. First there is an international West Indian conference in Martinique at the end of April. I would very much like for comrades in the West Indies to have anything at all that Information pour l'Intervention has done dealing with immigration. They should be sent to ~~Rox~~ Franklyn Harvey, C/o Cools, 2476 Coursol St., Montreal, 106, Quebec, Canada. Also, any material in French on women - a few copies of your abortion article should be sent immediately. I shall write and tell them to expect these things.

Second on finances for the 17th March. As Pris has written, a number of proletarian women would like to come, and in fact the women who have financial resources would not be in our political tendency. We are of course making a contribution to the other sisters going, but do you think it is possible to contact Maria and ask if she could get some money from some of her rich friends to help us here attend? You can say that I suggested it, if you think this would be of any value. We don't need very much - about £30 - say \$100, would see us all through. Not many will be coming in any case, but some of the finest will be there, hopefully.

The plans for the march are going ahead. How many will turn up is uncertain and I'm not sure ~~how~~ whether those in charge of publication have done a good job. We'll see.

On point one again, if you have a copy of Mariarosa's article translated into French can you also send at least one copy to Canada.

& forming a women's network

meet since he is not coming

& I am suggesting a session
on women. There is the
vaguest possibility in my
mind that I will go ^{to Montserrat} but
this is very vague & I'm
not even sure I would be
allowed either into Montserrat
or into the conference.

About your letter there is not
time. I also find the matter

distasteful & will not write
of it if you do not wish.
The matter cannot be so
easily closed ~~as we~~
do I think that it is
impossible to keep
opposites going together.
That is, you can have serious
disagreements with people
who make a great deal
to you - that ^{why} they
are persons. ^{a relationship is also work.} If I said more,
I would be preaching,
which I despise. I will
do as you say & let it
rest. There will be a
national meeting on Power
of women on the 31st March
& slowly but surely a network
is emerging. The decisive
thing is they cannot shake

us from control of the
family allowance campaign
& are burning up, holding
meetings where they invite
the Labour Party to give their
view as opposed to ours.
This is clearly not
feminism & all who want
to can see that. We are
riding a tide but it is
exhausting x
