Dear Mararosa,

I hope you have been well since I saw you in the winter. Are you on vacation now?

About a week ago I sent you some material about 3 Portuguese women who wrote a feminist book together, & are going to be tried for "obscenity". A group of us here - (some French, North American & Latin American), have been working on this together, trying to get articles published in the liberal (not journalistic) press. I thought perhaps you could spread information about the case among the women in the movement, and if you know anyone in the press, get some articles written in Italy.

Some women from Paris presented this at the International Feminist Congress of NOW in Boston, & there was a good deal of publicity & articles & support. There were demonstrations in several cities at the Portuguese embassies. As a result the trial has been postponed to Oct 25(?)

We aren't working with Paych. & Pal, but with some feminists Revolutionnaires including Monique Wittig. Next time you come I'll introduce you to them - I think you'll like them.

I was in London, but Selma wasn't there. Spent some time with Prescille.
