Dear Friends and Subscribers,

We need to raise \$1105 before August 1 in order to print and send out the next issue. And we need to raise approximately \$4000 by the end of this year to remain solvent. So we are asking you to help us.

There are several things you can do. The first is to send us as large a contribution as you can as soon as you can. Please be as generous as possible. The second is to subscribe in advance and/or sell subscriptions. We currently have 2500 subscribers. If we could double the number of our subscribers, we would be on the road to financial independence. In the long run, that is our aim. And the third thing you might do, if you are teaching at a college, is to use the journal in the courses you teach.

Aside from financial worries, we are optimistic about the next few years. It looks like the Watergate hearings will discredit Nixon's repressive policies, and provide a new opening for the growth of the left, after experiencing the pessimism and feelings of powerlessness that characterized the mood of the country in the last few years.

On the journal itself, we are also becoming more confident about our ability to keep putting out good issues. Around the country, there are more people each year who are analysing the society from a Marxist perspective. We can see this in the number and quality of the articles we get, as well as from talking to people who come visit us in San Francisco.

We want to urge you -- whether or not you are able to help us financially -- to write us your impressions of Socialist Revolution, or come visit us when you come to the west coast. And we're also interested in seeing anything you might be writing that you think we would be interested in publishing.
