But we do the best that we can + I hope that if I take a week away from everyone + everything, I will begin

to recover. I have really  
done too much work over  
these two years & I am  
feeling very, very low.

So - you must help me  
a little. We really need  
to work out a set of  
demands to counterpose  
to a set of women in the  
Trade unions here, & also  
because we are late in  
putting our politics on this  
concrete way. The political  
situation in Britain  
should give ~~of~~ us many  
opportunities at this  
moment, & it is up to us to  
take them. These demands  
are vital. You mentioned  
on the phone that you were

working on a list of  
demands to end the  
document on the wage.  
Please, unless I have  
misunderstood, send them  
immediately.

As for the circulation  
of information on the  
dissolution of L.F. Love  
that to me. It is my  
state of health, mentally  
& physically, which has  
kept me back and the work  
for the BBC which is like  
a death for me now. But  
it will <sup>all</sup> be done in time.

Send us ~~all~~ all the good  
news of your activities  
when you have time. The  
news of the U.S. - N. America

- is good. we have some  
functioning groups now.  
And I think they have a  
stable base: Montreal,  
Toronto, Philadelphia,  
N.Y. & Los Angeles. (I  
tell you that I don't  
want to go back for a  
while; I hated to go this  
time & hated to speak.  
Now it is not necessary!  
That is a triumph.)
