Silvia suggested that I write you on the off chance that you will be in Italy in the middle of August and that I might be able to stay with you or some of your ~~my~~ comrades. At Silvia's suggestion, I also am writing to Ferruccio Bambino and Poldo Fortunati in Padova ~~in~~ (hoping ~~to~~ that I got their names and addresses right).

Would it be possible for you to send me an answer as soon as you receive my letter?
