We received the packet you sent and some of these things raise some questions to me that I hope you will respond to.

Why did you not meet with or want to set up a meeting with the points of reference of the North American Campaign- or any of us here?

Why is it Sylvia that you relate to about North America, when she is not now in the network, or even in contact with the rest of the North American Campaign?

What is this New York Committee that you refer to- that we have never seen, or heard from or have any idea of what it's doing? There is a New York Committee now functioning as part of the network and it has not had any contact from Sylvia.

Why do you speak of Sylvia as being expelled, when no such thing happened? At the regional meeting of August 1977 that I attended, Sylvia said she couldn't be in the network at that time and the rest of us agreed with her. She also said she would continue to work with us and even as recently as last November we were offering work she could do with us.

Having not heard from you again, I do not know if you are still in the States or if you ever did manage to travel and speak around the country. How was your trip? Will you be back again? I hope to hear from you and I hope that all this can be cleared up so we can make the campaign together and all of us win our wages.
